C. Evidence of successful mentoring

Mentoring is an important aspect of my career. In addition to mentoring individual trainees, I am responsible for training activities at the programmatic level. I am co-Director of the Professional Development Committee for the PVAMC CfNN, and lead two rehabilitation research training centers CoHSTAR and LeaRRn- which provide training opportunities for postdoctoral fellows, faculty fellows, Scholars and mentored pilot awardees. I completed an Advance-CTR Mentoring Training Program hosted at Brown University.
