I am a board certified psychiatrist with specialty interests in Psychosomatic Medicine and Geriatric Psychiatry. After finishing a fellowship in psychosomatic medicine I took on the assistant directorship of the consultation-liaison service at the Miriam Hospital in Providence, RI, one of the teaching hospitals for Brown University.

I have become increasingly interested in medical education, particularly novel methods of teaching. This led to my becoming involved with several national organizations dedicated to psychiatric education, such as the Association for Academic Psychiatry (AAP) where I expanded my understanding of innovative methods of psychiatric education, and presented regularly. I took on more leadership roles within medical education, both at my university and nationally: locally I helped to oversee both residency and medical student education and directing the preclinical psychiatry course. I've also been interested in innovative methods to train the next generation of psychiatrist-scientist, and was a co-investigator on an R21 devoted to this challenge. Nationally I am a past-president of AAP, President Elect of the American Association of Directors of Psychiatry Residency Training, and will be President of the Academy of Psychosomatic Medicine (APM) in 2017. In these roles I have devoted a good deal of interest toward the use of technology in education, writing, presenting and organizing workshops and plenaries on this subject, as well as developing online self-assessment courses and training modules for various national organizations (for example, creating the Maintenance of Certification modules for APM, and editing the APA's online assessment journal, e-Focus). I've also published on medical education, including on evaluation methods, teaching professionalism and scholarly activity during residency, and on novel educational methods. As a former training director and now Vice Chair of Education, I appreciate the importance of evaluation and feedback and have worked to improve these – first at Brown and now as part of the Longwood residency, where, for example, I created a novel real time smart phone evaluation system for the didactic program. Nationally, I am involved with the ACGME in implementing the next accreditation system for psychiatry: I was a workshop member for the Psychiatry Milestones, and chair the Psychosomatic Milestones Workgroup; and serve as a member of their Residency Review Committee.

My clinical expertise focuses on the influence of depression on medical illness. While directing the Miriam Hospital Consultation service, I became interested in HIV psychiatry and in this regard became involved in several research studies, such as the CDC-sponsored HIV Epidemiological Research Study, where I helped lead the psychosocial arm of that study. We published several important findings, including the positive effect of HAART therapy on cognition and the impact of alcohol on disease progression, but concentrated on the influence on depression at each stage of the illness. This led to a general interest in major depression, and pursuing this, I helped with the end phase of the NIH-sponsored Collaborative Depression Study—Clinical Section, one of the longest natural studies of the course of depression, analyzing 30 year data from that study and helping to disseminate the final results.
