6. Research in progress:

I have completed field research on a National Science Foundation grant for the a comparative study of infertility in two ethnic groups in Nigeria, the Yakurr and the Ijo, to be conducted with Oka Obono

of the University of Ibadan and Ulla Larsen of Harvard University. The title of the study is "The cultural construction of infertility in Southern Nigeria". This research commenced during the summer of 2005 and continued for three consecutive summers. During the summer of 2006 the research team was joined by Bruce Whitehouse, a post-doctoral fellow who is supported by my NSF grant. So far we published three Papers and one paper is in press.

I have been invited by members of the Max Planck Institute for Demographic Research in Rostock, Germany to participate in a comparative study of low fertility in three East European countries, including Hungary, Poland and Bulgaria. I directed the Hungarian portion of the research, the interviews for which have been completed. Data analysis continues and I delivered a working paper during the spring of 2006, entitled Childbearing in times of anxiety: Young couples in Hungary. A further paper was delivered at the

Annual meetings of the American Anthropological Association in December 2007.

I am currently applying for a National Science Foundation research grant to continue work on low fertility in Hungary. The title of the project is "Now, later or never: Voluntary and involuntary childlessness in Hungary".
